After decades of fundraising and planning (and lobbying), the **Reed City** Baldwin ultimate dream of a fully developed trail is finally coming true. In the fall of 2023, the 22-mile unfinished section from Howard City Hersey to Big Rapids was nearly completed, paved with rubberized asphalt, and should be finished this summer or fall. During construction, three culverts collapsed under the weight of machinery, which delayed Paris paving, and (pending engineering and permitting) must be replaced Trails Legend or repaired. One culvert between M-46 and Yankee Road will be Paved Trail replaced with a bridge. In a 3.5-mile section between Angling and New Under Development **Big Rapids** Millpond Roads (south of Big Rapids), one culvert will be replaced and Limestone Trail Highways the other repaired. Expect closures and/or detours for these sections if Roads you're riding the trail this summer. Look for updates on our Michigan 131 Trails Facebook page. All the other sections are ready to go! Established in 1995, the Fred Meijer White Pine Trail State Park is the longest linear state park in Michigan. "The Great White Pine" stretches 93 miles from Comstock Park (near Grand Rapids) along Stanwood (20) the former Michigan Northern section of the Penn Central Railroad White Cloud to Cadillac through 31 cities, villages and townships. When you head north on the White Pine Trail, you'll discover a **NEWAYGO** quiet, scenic corridor that takes you through several trailside parks, Morley quaint villages, farms, meadows, wetlands, shady tunnels of trees, wide expanses of unspoiled nature and, as advertised, towering stands

of mature white pine forest. The entire length of trail runs parallel to US-131, providing easy access along its route. And because it was built on an abandoned railroad, the grade is fairly flat and well suited for people of all physical abilities. Each section of trail has its own natural features and unique personality. In the following pages we will introduce you to each section of this magnificent trail.
