## Calhoun County Trailway

The Calhoun County Trailway was completed in November 2014. The 5.28-mile nonmotorized multi-use trail connects Battle Creek Linear Park to Historic Bridge Park, traveling through Ott Biological Preserve and Kimball Pines County Park, and intersecting the North Country Trail. The 10-foot-wide trail surface is finely crushed and compacted gravel with several scenic stretches of elevated boardwalks. The section of trail through Ott Biological Preserve is exceptionally scenic.
